confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of NESTUCCA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45185. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 3 S, R 9 W, W.M; 300 FEET NORTH & 1500 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER SECTION 27.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
