that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 1.42 cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total cuantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

20 acres in the NW_4^1 of NW_4^2 ; 33 acres in the SW_4^1 of NW_4^1 ; 33 acres in the NW_4^1 ; of SW_4^1 ; 27 acres in the SW_4^1 ; Section Twenty-six (26), Township Fourteen (14), South Range Seventeen (17) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.
