CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HAROLD AND BETH ROWEN  
R.R. 212  
HALFWAY, OREGON 97834

confirms the right to use the waters of CLEAR CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-983, A TRIBUTARY OF CLEAR CREEK, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 38.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40793. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.96 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 6 S, R 46 E, W.M.;  
SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 8 S, R 46 E, W.M.; RESERVOIR SOUTH 57 DEGREES 23 MINUTES EAST 5723 FEET FROM S1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, T 5 S, R 46 E; REDIVERSION FROM CLEAR CREEK - 1300 FEET NORTH & 960 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

38.2 ACRES SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 4  
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
