confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, tributary of EAST BEAVER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE FOR EACH FAMILY.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45973. The date of priority is AUGUST 21, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 3 S, R 9 W, W.M.; 30 FEET SOUTH & 730 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 17.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
