CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary TO WEST FORK MOSIER CREEK, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48306. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 23, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 2 N, R 11 E, W.M.;  
2020 FEET SOUTH & 530 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF NW 1/4 NW 1/4,  
SECTION 25.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 25  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
