CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CONRAD AND GWENDOLYN SCHUBKEGEL

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 24.7 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70. The date of priority is 1857.

The right is limited to not more than ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 40 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 2750 FEET SOUTH AND 3920 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 17.5 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 ACRE
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 4, 1979, and together with certificate 48978, supersedes certificate 43597, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
