CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN DARREL CLOW
ROUTE 1, BOX 192 A
DAYTON, OREGON 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the PALMER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 9.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-8384. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 56,
SECTION 16, T 5 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 340 FEET SOUTH & 490 FEET EAST FROM NW
CORNER DLC 56.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 9.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 56
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
