CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERNEST B. AND ALMA W. SORENSEN 4154 DEER CREEK ROAD SELMA, OREGON 97538

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKS CREEK, a tributary of DEER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 41857. The date of priority is MARCH 24, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.075 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 38 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 470 FEET NORTH & 1290 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 6.0 ACRES SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
