CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WAYNE C. FILLOON  
7900 TAKILMA ROAD  
CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of ELDER CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 42552. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 23,  
T 40 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 310 FEET NORTH & 1600 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER  
SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.4 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.2 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
