and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the First FATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 2.5 cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total cuantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

30 acres in the SW1 of NE1; 40 acres in the SE2 of SW2; 30 acres in the NV2 of SE1; 20 acres in the SW2 of SE2; Section Thirty-five (35) Township Thirteen (13) South Range Seventeen (17) East of Willamette Meridian: 26 acres in the NE2 of NV1; 20 acres in the SW4 of NV2; 34 acres in the SE3 of NV3; Section Two (2), Township Fourteen (14) South Range Seventeen (17) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
