confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of NESTUCCA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45976. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 3, T 4 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 350 FEET NORTH & 300 FEET WEST FROM THE E1/4 CORNER SECTION 2.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 3 TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
