confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of NORTH FORK OF THE NEHALEM RIVER, for the purpose of OPERATION OF A HYDRAULIC RAM AND DOMESTIC AT A CAMP SITE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47175. The date of priority is AUGUST 2, 1982, FOR DOMESTIC USE AND OCTOBER 7, 1982, FOR OPERATION OF THE HYDRAULIC RAM. The right is limited to not more than 5.6 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 0.6 GPM FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 5 GPM FOR OPERATION OF THE HYDRAULIC RAM or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 32, T 4 N, R 9 W, W.M.; 150 FEET NORTH & 60 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF LOT 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 32.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
