## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GORDON AND ISA M. BOSWORTH AND INA LOUISE AND KEITH E. PAULSON P.O. BOX 26 TIDEWATER, OREGON 97390

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of THE ALSEA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND IRRIGATION OF 1.83 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49945. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1986. The right is limited to not more than 11.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 4.5 GPM FOR DOMESTIC AND 6.5 GPM FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 13 S, R 10 W, W.M.; 4202 FEET NORTH & 740 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.73 ACRE AND DOMESTIC NE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.10 ACRES AND DOMESTIC SECTION 34 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
