CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.D. JOHN
WILLIAMS, OREGON 97544

confirms the right to use the waters of MUNGER CREEK, a tributary of WEST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 25.0 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK WATERING.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is 1879.

The right is limited to not more than 0.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO SUPERSEDE THE WATER RIGHT EVIDENCED BY THE CERTIFICATE RECORDED AT PAGE 16348, VOLUME 13, STATE RECORD OF WATER RIGHT CERTIFICATES, TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE LOCATION OF THE PLACE OF USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMENDED JUDGEMENT AND DECREE ENTERED NOVEMBER 23, 1988, BY THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR JOSEPHINE COUNTY ENTERED IN THE ORDER RECORD OF THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR VOLUME 18, PAGE 479.

THE ISSUANCE OF THIS SUPERSEDING CERTIFICATE DOES NOT CONFIRM THE STATUS OF THE WATER RIGHT IN REGARD TO THE PROVISIONS OF ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
