CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That GEORGE JOHNSON

of Pleasant Valley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Alder Creek, a tributary of Burnt River
 for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority
 of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 1883;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
 acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Para-
 graph 64 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
 (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Seven (7) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$),
 Section Twenty-two (22); Thirteen (13) acres in the Northeast Quarter of
 the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Thirty (30) acres in the Northwest Quarter
 of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Eighteen (18) acres in the Southwest
 Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Twenty-three (23), Town-
 ship Ten (10) South, Range Forty-one (41) East of the Willamette Meridian,
 being a total of 68 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
