The right is for flows to be maintained IN WILLAMINA CREEK FROM USGS GAGE NO. 14-1930, NEAR WILLAMINA, (SECTION 13, T 5 S, R 7 W, W.M.), TO THE MOUTH.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
