confirms the right to use the waters of HILLS CREEK, a tributary of the MIDDLE FORK WILLAMETTE RIVER, in the WILLAMETTE BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND MINIMIZING POLLUTION.

The right is for flows OF HILLS CREEK AT ITS MOUTH (NEAR JASPER, SECTION 14, T 18 S, R 2 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 31	1
NOV 1 - NOV 15	6
NOV 16- MAY 31	12
JUN 1 - JUN 15	8
JUL 16- JUN 30	4
JUL 1 - JUL 30	2
AUG 1 - SEP 30	1

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic and livestock consumption or water legally released from storage for other purposes.
