confirms the right to use the waters of ALSEA RIVER, a tributary of the ALSEA BAY, in the MIDDLE COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE ALSEA RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH SOUTH FORK ALSEA RIVER (SE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 14 S, R 8 W, W.M.) TO USGS-WRD GAGE 14-3065 AT STREAM MILE 17.2 (NW 1/4, SECTION 6, T 14 S, R 9 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.


The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 15	50
OCT 16- OCT 31	100
NOV 1 - DEC 31	140
JAN 1 - APR 30	130
MAY 1 - MAY 31	85
JUN 1 - JUN 30	50
JUL 1 - SEP 30	25

This instream water right shall not have priority over the right to use water for human consumption, livestock consumption, the use of waters legally released from storage or 5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND RESERVED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES BELOW MILE 25.
