CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of FIVE RIVERS, a tributary of the ALSEA RIVER, in the MIDDLE COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN FIVE RIVERS FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH LOBSTER CREEK (SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 14 S, R 9 W, W.M.), TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE ALSEA RIVER, (SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 14 S, R 9 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 15	40
OCT 16- OCT 31	80
NOV 1 - APR 30	140
MAY 1 - MAY 31	100
JUN 1 - JUN 30	50
JUL 1 - JUL 31	30
AUG 1 - SEP 30	25

This instream water right shall not have priority over the right to use water for human consumption, livestock consumption or the use of waters legally released from storage.

The flows listed above include flows established by earlier dated instream water rights.
