that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose Saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 89/100 cubic foot per second for irrigation from July let to September 15th of each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system/ordered by the proper state officer.
