CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of YACHATS RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, in the MIDDLE COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE YACHATS RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE NORTH FORK OF THE YACHATS RIVER, (SW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 14 S, R 11 W, W.M.), TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH BEAMER CREEK, (SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 14 S, R 11 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.


The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 15	20
OCT 16- OCT 31	40
NOV 1 - NOV 30	50
DEC 1 - DEC 31	60
JAN 1 - APR 30	50
MAY 1 - MAY 31	30
JUN 1 - JUN 30	20
JUL 1 - SEP 30	10

This instream water right shall not have priority over the right to use water for human consumption, livestock consumption, the use of waters legally released from storage.

The flows listed above include flows established by earlier dated instream water rights.
