The right is for flows to be maintained FROM THE CONFLUENCE OF HARLISS CREEK (NE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 2 N, R 9 W, W.M.) TO THE CONFLUENCE WITH THE NEHALEM RIVER (SW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 3 N, R 9 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MAY 9, 1973.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
