confirms the right to use the waters of SMITH RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows of SMITH RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES ABOVE ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE NORTH FORK SMITH RIVER (SECTION 31, T 20 S, R 10 W, W.M.) MEASURED IMMEDIATELY BELOW THE MOUTH OF NORTH FORK SMITH RIVER.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is OCTOBER 24, 1958.

The right is limited to not more than 20 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic use, livestock consumption, irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area and waters legally stored or legally released from storage.
