CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SMITH RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN SMITH RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES ABOVE SMITH RIVER FALLS (SECTION 31, T 20 S, R 9 W) MEASURED AT OR NEAR THE FALLS.


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is OCTOBER 24, 1958.

The right is limited to not more than 15 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic use, livestock consumption, irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area and waters legally stored or legally released from storage.
