confirms the right to use the waters of MARYS RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, in the WILLAMETTE BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE MARYS RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES, TO BE MEASURED AT A POINT BETWEEN THE CONFLUENCE OF THE MARYS RIVER AND THE WILLAMETTE RIVER AND 1.0 MILE ABOVE SAID CONFLUENCE.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JUNE 22, 1964.

The right is limited to not more than 5 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic or livestock uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
