The right is for flows to be maintained IN FALL CREEK FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH CARNS CANYON CREEK (NW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 13 S, R 9 W, W.M.) TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE ALSEA RIVER, (SW 1/4, SECTION 1, T 14 S, R 9 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JULY 12, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
