confirms the right to use the waters of SALMON RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, in the MID COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE SALMON RIVER FROM THE OLD U.S. 101 HWY CROSSING AT RIVER MILE 5 (SW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 6 S, R 10 W, W.M.), TO THE MOUTH OF THE SALMON RIVER.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.


The date of priority is JULY 12, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - OCT 15	60
OCT 16- DEC 31	150
JAN 1 - MAY 31	120
JUN 1 - JUL 15	35
JUL 16- SEP 15	18
SEP 16- SEP 30	30

This instream water right shall not affect domestic or livestock uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
