confirms the right to use the waters of YACHATS RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, in the MID COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND RECREATION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE YACHATS RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE NORTH FORK OF THE YACHATS RIVER (SW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 14 S, R 11 W, W.M.), TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH BEAMER CREEK, (SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 14 S, R 11 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is JULY 12, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

This instream water right shall not affect domestic or livestock uses, waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage or 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND RESERVED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSE BELOW RIVER MILE 5.0.
