The right is for flows IN THE HOOD RIVER AT POWERDALE DIVERSION DAM MAINTAINED TO THE MOUTH OF HOOD RIVER.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 30, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than 45 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic, livestock, or municipal uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
