CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT
SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of MIDDLE FORK HOOD RIVER, a tributary of the HOOD RIVER, in the HOOD RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE MIDDLE FORK OF HOOD RIVER AT THE MOUTH.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 30, 1966.

The right is limited to not more than 10 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic, livestock, or municipal uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
