CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of GATE CREEK, a tributary of the MCKENZIE RIVER, in the WILLAMETTE BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN GATE CREEK AND ITS TRIBUTARIES ABOVE THE GATE CREEK - MCKENZIE RIVER CONFLUENCE, MEASURED AT A POINT BETWEEN SAID CONFLUENCE AND 1.0 MILE ABOVE SAID CONFLUENCE.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MAY 24, 1962.

The right is limited to not more than 20 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic or livestock uses or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
