The right is for flows to be maintained IN DEER CREEK FROM HIGHWAY 199 BRIDGE (SECTION 11, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M.), TO ITS MOUTH.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

This instream water right shall not have priority over appropriations of water for domestic or livestock uses or waters legally stored or released from storage. Domestic use does not include irrigation of lawns and gardens.
