confirms the right to use the waters of FRUITDALE CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, in the ROGUE RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND MINIMIZING POLLUTION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN FRUITDALE CREEK, (SW 1/4, SECTION 21, T 36 S, R 5 W, W.M.), AT THE MOUTH.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.


The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 29, 1969.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (cubic feet per second)</u>
OCT 1 - APR 30	4
MAY 1 - MAY 31	2
JUN 1 - SEP 15	1
SEP 16- SEP 30	4

This instream water right shall not have priority over appropriations of water for domestic or livestock uses or waters legally stored or released from storage. Domestic use does not include irrigation of lawns and gardens.
