The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE JOHN DAY RIVER BETWEEN THE MOUTH OF THE SOUTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER (SECTION 1, T 13 S, R 26 E, W.M.) AND THE MOUTH OF THE NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER (SECTION 30, T 9 S, R 26 E, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1983.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

Period	Flows (cubic feet per second)
OCT 1 - OCT 31	60
NOV 1 - FEB 15	120
FEB 16- MAY 31	160
JUN 1 - JUN 30	120
JUL 1 - SEP 30	60

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic, livestock uses and municipal uses from USGS gage 14038530 to the North Fork. Also, industrial use rights and industrial use under permits with priority dates before December 2, 1986, from USGS gage 14038530 to the North fork and water legally stored or released from storage.
