confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, in the JOHN DAY RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER ABOVE FORMER USGS GAGE NO. 14-041 NEAR DALE (SECTION 35, T 6 S, R 31 E, W.M.) AS MEASURED AT THE SITE OF THE GAGE.


The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MAY 24, 1962.

The right is limited to not more than 35 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not affect domestic or livestock uses or waters legally stored or legally released from storage.
