CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT
SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, in the ROGUE RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE AND MINIMIZING POLLUTION.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN ROGUE RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES ABOVE GOLD RAY DAM (SECTION 18, T 37 S, R 2 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.


The date of priority is MAY 22, 1959.

The right is limited to not more than 1000 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not affect domestic or livestock uses or waters legally stored or legally released from storage.

This instream water right shall not affect rights to appropriate water, from the main stem Rogue River, for the irrigation of one acre or less, with priority dates earlier than June 19, 1984.
