THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK COQUILLE, a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER, in the SOUTH COAST BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER BELOW THE CONFLUENCE OF NEELY CREEK AND MAINTAINED TO ABOVE THE CONFLUENCE OF WHITLEY CREEK, (SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 11 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MAY 22, 1964.

The right is limited to not more than 8 cubic feet per second throughout the year.

This instream water right shall not have priority over domestic and livestock uses and irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area or waters to be legally stored or legally released from storage.
