CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

JOHN C. NIEDERER

This is to Certify, That

La Grande, Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of N. Fork of Burnt River  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said ~~right~~ has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1892, at page ; that the priority  
of the right thereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to ~~three~~ <sup>three</sup> acre feet  
per acre during the irrigation season (with no further limitations contained in  
Paragraph 64 of said decree);

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty-three (23) acres in the Southwest Quarter of the  
Northeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and Nineteen (19) acres in the  
Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of  
Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Ten (10) South, Range  
Thirty-six (36) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a  
total of 42 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
