confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK SMITH RIVER, a tributary of the SMITH RIVER, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE NORTH FORK SMITH RIVER AT OR NEAR ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE SMITH RIVER, (NE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 21 S, R 10 W, W.M).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

OCT 1 - OCT 15 10 CT 16 - OCT 31 30
NOV 1 - NOV 30 90 DEC 1 - APR 30 70 MAY 1 - MAY 31 50 JUN 1 - JUN 30 30
MOV = 1 - MOV = 3.0

This instream water right shall not have priority over appropriations of water for human consumption, livestock consumption and irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area and waters legally released from storage.

The flows listed above include flows established by earlier dated instream water rights.
