## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8 , at page 134; that the priority 1875 of the right thereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an Three acre feet amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed per acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said decree;)

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> Two and five tenths (2.5) acres in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW1NE1), Sixteen (16) scres in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW1NE1), Sixteen (16) acres in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE4NE4), Fourteen (14) acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE1SE1), Section Two (2), Township Eleven (11) South, Range Forty-two (42) East of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 48.5 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
