The right is for flows to be maintained IN LITTLE RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH EMILE CREEK, (SE 1/4, SECTION 2, T 27 S, R 2 W, W.M.), TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH CAVITT CREEK, (NE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 27 S, R 3 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
