confirms the right to use the waters of OLALLA CREEK, a tributary of the LOOKINGGLASS CREEK, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN OLALLA CREEK FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH BERRY CREEK, (SE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 29 S, R 7 W, W.M.), TO ITS CONFLUENCE WITH TENMILE CREEK, (SW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 28 S, R 7 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:
