confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH COW CREEK, (SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.), TO THE USGS GAGE NO. 14-3120 AT STREAM MILE 21.2, (NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 38 S, R 6 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

This instream water right shall not have priority over appropriations of water for human consumption, livestock consumption and irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area and waters legally released from storage.
