confirms the right to use the waters of UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, in the UMPQUA RIVER BASIN to maintain an instream flow for the purpose of SUPPORTING AQUATIC LIFE.

The right is for flows to be maintained IN THE UMPQUA RIVER FROM ITS CONFLUENCE WITH THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, (NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.), TO ITS MOUTH, (SW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 22 S, R 13 W, W.M.).

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statutes 537.346.

The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1974.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the time periods listed below:

This instream water right shall not have priority over appropriations of water for human consumption, livestock consumption and irrigation of non-commercial gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area and waters legally released from storage.

The flows listed above include flows established by earlier dated instream water rights.
