CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

M. A. CROSS
BOX 22 WEAVER ROAD

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 12.7 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 19266. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 14, 1950. The right is limited to not more than 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION; SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40, SECTION 5, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39, SECTION 6, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 735 FEET NORTH & 815 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 7.7 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 40
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.6 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 39
SECTION 6

TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 15, 1980, and together with certificate 50484, supersedes certificate 45149, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
