that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.71 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Twelve acres in NE2 of SW2; seven acres in SW2 of SW2; sixteen and one-half acres in SE2 of SW2; Sec. 19; fourteen acres in NW2 of NW2, Sec. 30, Tp. 21 S. R. 11 E., W. M., all in Crook County, State of Oregon.
