confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of FISH PASSAGEWAY AND RECREATION.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1902.

The right is limited to not more than 52.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 50.0 CFS FOR FISH PASSAGEWAY, AND 2.0 CFS TO MAINTAIN GOLD RAY POOL FOR RECREATION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 36 S, R 2 W, W.M.; GOLD RAY DAM.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

FISH PASSAGEWAY E 1/2 SW 1/4 SECTION 18

RECREATION POOL S 1/2 NE 1/4 N 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 18

N 1/2 NE 1/4
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 24, 1977, and also describes that portion of the water right NOT CANCELLED by special order entered SEPTEMBER 15, 1977, and supersedes certificate 15838, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
