CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DEAN MAYFIELD
6451 HOLLAND LOOP ROAD
CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 253. The date of priority is 1875.

The right is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND THAT THE USE OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES SHALL BE CONFINED TO THE SEASON APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 39 S, R 7 W, W.M.; HOLLAND DITCH-
1280 FEET NORTH AND 2680 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 15, 1981, and together with certificate 50158, supersedes certificate 7144, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
