CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to store the waters of SCHOOL HOUSE CREEK, a tributary of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, in WOOLFOLK RESERVOIR, appropriated under Permit 23116, for the purpose of IRRIGATION.

The right to store these waters has been perfected under Reservoir Permit R-1662. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1954. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right is not more than 175.5 ACRE FEET.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 5, 1978, and together with certificate 46568, supersedes certificate 41766, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
