CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROD DABERKOW
13415 MONMOUTH HIGHWAY
MONMOUTH, OREGON 97361

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND DABERKOW RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7668, a tributary of COOPER HOLLOW CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.5 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

The right has been perfected under Permit 43300. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1978. The right is limited to not more than 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 8 S, R 5 W, W.M.;
400 FEET NORTH & AND 480 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.9 ACRE AND STOCK
SECTION 28
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.6 ACRE
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
